BLACK TEA

This tea has been carefully selected to celebrate the centenary of Rufflets. This signature blend is masterfully blended with a highly aromatic and a very light smoky note. A charismatic black tea with a complex profile to match the rich history that inspired it.

EARL GREY WITH BLUE FLOWERS

The popular, slightly spicy black tea is enriched with natural flavours of fresh, citrus, light bergamot fruits. Apart from the noble characteristic taste, the bright blue mallow blossoms give this popular classic a touch of royal flair.

ASSAM

This Mangalam Tea Estate is known to produce one of the finest Assam teas in the entire region. Malty and rich, with its large leaf and opulent golden tips, this premium single estate Assam tea will be the jewel of any tea assortment.

LAPSANG SOUCHONG

When producing the best Lapsang Souchong tea only the Souchong leaf, which is riper and larger, is plucked from the lower parts of the tea bushes. After fermentation, these leaves are put on hot iron plates and roasted before smoking the tea over carefully pine wood, which is rich in resin. The taste is smoky with a hint of spicy note and is perfect for those who enjoy this blend.
